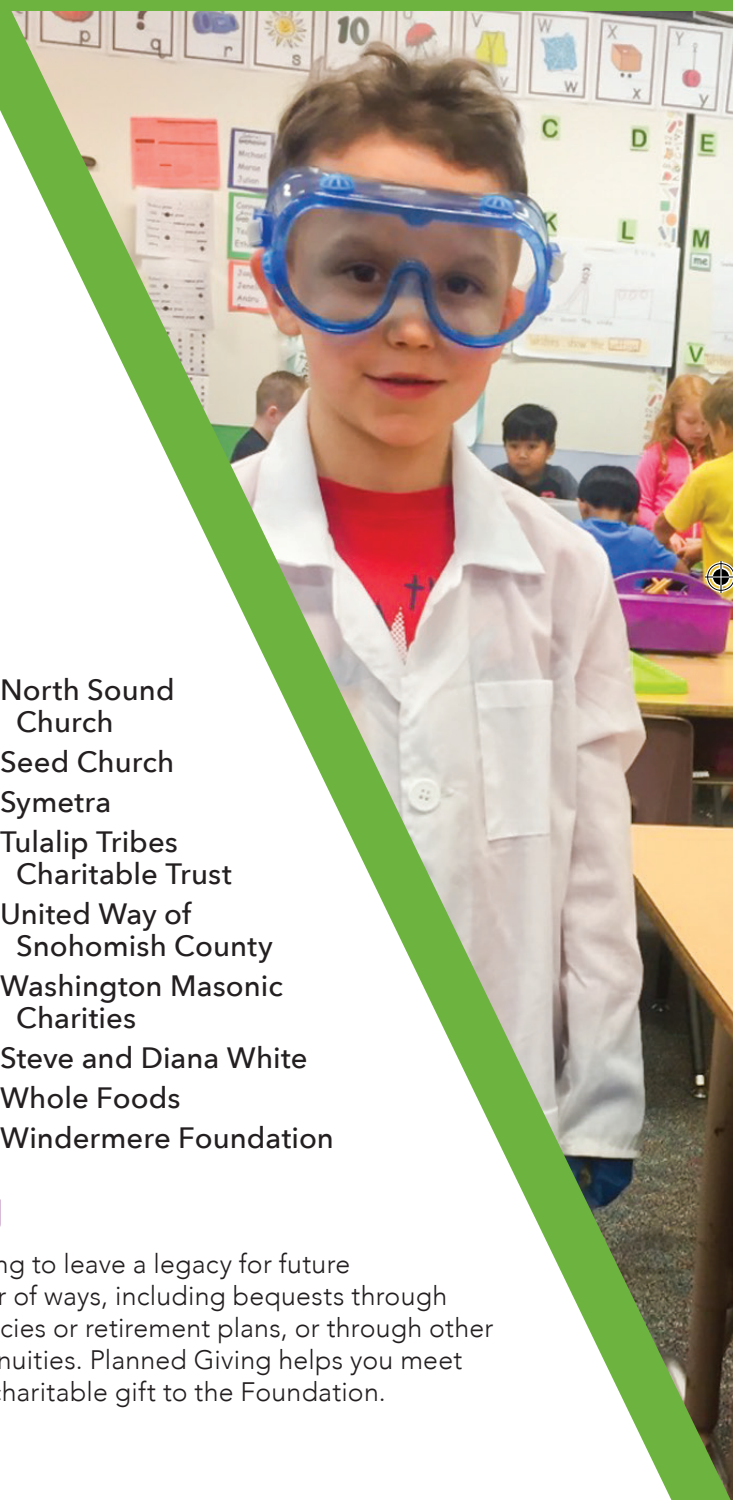

About the Nourishing Network

In 2014, the Foundation for Edmonds School District launched the Nourishing Network program in partnership with and at the request of the Edmonds School District. What originally started as weekend meals to feed our hungry and homeless students has quickly blossomed into more comprehensive programs to help sustain our most fragile students.

The Need

Today, over 600 Edmond School District students are homeless. On average, 36% of our families are on free and reduced lunch programs. Often these students leave school Friday and do not have another meal until Monday morning.

How We Nourish

- **Weekend Meals** – 190+ students in 23 schools are served weekly.
- **Holiday Meals** – 82 holiday meals went to families before the December 2017 school break
- **Summer Meals** – In 2015 we piloted a summer meal program that served 13 students for six weeks. Since then, our summer meal program has expanded to three sites serving more than 50 children for the entire summer. In addition to a nutritious lunch, children participate in fun and educational activities that engage their bodies and minds in a free day camp environment.
- **Hygiene Products** – Both basic care items and feminine hygiene products are provided monthly.
- **Future Plans in Development** – Together with other partners, we are exploring ways to support families with their needs for clothing, rent assistance, transportation and student mentoring.

Our Network

We cannot do this incredibly meaningful work alone. With your generous help and the help of our caring community, Nourishing Network provides these essential services to families in need. Our network of over forty Community Partners, including faith-based organizations, local businesses, civic groups, and other volunteer organizations, help us in many ways including monetary gifts, fundraisers or food drives, and also with their time helping to sort and shelf food in our pantry, or to pack food each week for students.
