## Dear Foundation Donors,

College Place Elementary has benefited greatly from Foundation for Edmonds School District programs. As principal, I have seen first-hand how Foundation-funded programs are improving the lives and strengthening the futures for our students and families. This work is possible because of your generous support. Thank you!

As recipients of the new Whole Families, Whole Communities (WFWC) program, we have been able to make several things happen. We are now able to fund our Family Resource Advocate as a full-time, not just half-time position in our building. When families come to her in crisis, she helps to create plans for them to move them out of crisis and on the road to stability. By connecting families with this WFWC network of community agencies, she is better equipped to help them "get back on their feet". Now that she full-time, she can serve twice as many families. We are a school where 70% of our families qualify for free or reduced lunch, and many of our families have limited English skills, so they rely on us for support. We are able to support more families and at higher levels thanks to financial support from the Foundation.

The Foundation also supports us with time for teachers to work with families to tutor not only students, but also their families so that parents or guardians can learn how to better support them academically at home. Teachers work directly with families for an hour after school two days a week. During this time, the Foundation also provides childcare for younger siblings so that parents can better focus on the child and the teacher they were working with.

The Foundation has also supported our families through the Nourishing Network program. Now that the Nourishing Network delivers weekend meals directly to our campus, our Family Resource Advocate can focus her time on Family Success Plans, rather than purchasing food for our food pantry.

I have to say one more way that The Foundation has gone above and beyond is that Deb Anderson personally attended monthly meetings with our Family Group to show them how to run a PTA or PTO type organization, how to work through financial challenges and create effective plans for organization and fund raising. She has been selfless in her support for our families and I appreciate her dedication to the work of helping others to help themselves.

I can't thank you enough for all that has been done for the College Place Elementary Community.

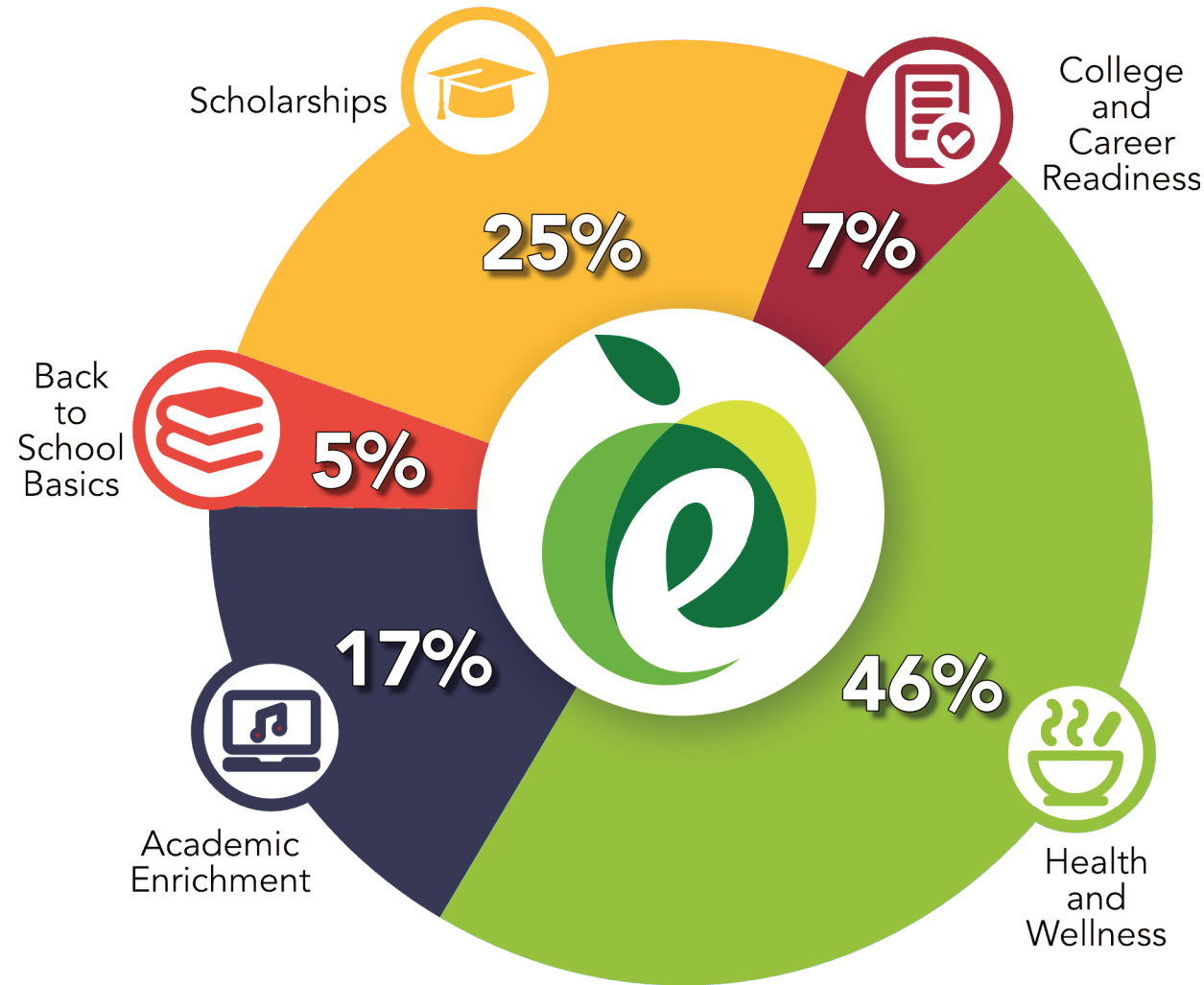

24 teachers received Creative Classroom Grants and 35 schools were awarded Schoolwide Grants.

263 teachers were reimbursed for the purchase of classroom supplies

373 students received small group instruction

# Whole Families, Whole Communities

In June and July 2018, the [Foundation for Edmonds School District](#) received \$175,000 in funding support of its new program, [Whole Families, Whole Communities \(WFWC\)](#) from both the [Whitehorse Foundation](#) and [Elizabeth Ruth Wallace Living Trust](#).

[WFWC](#) was developed in partnership with the [Edmonds School District](#) to support the needs of the district's growing population of students and families experiencing poverty or homelessness. Children faced with obstacles at home such as hunger, homelessness, financial uncertainty, or violence may be less healthy, and often struggle in the classroom. All these factors may impact their ability to succeed during their educational career.

[The Foundation](#) has designed [WFWC](#) in response to these needs. [WFWC](#) is a collaborative social services model, made possible through an organized network of community partners. The intent is to make it easier for families to access a robust suite of community resources that will strengthen their family unit. With our partners, we are working to increase financial stability and improve homelessness prevention resources for low-income families living in the [Edmonds School District](#).
