Verdant Health Commission Awards Foundation for Edmonds School District \$97,000 Across Multiple Grants for Nutrition and Wellness Support Programs

The Foundation has received \$97,000 in grants from Verdant Health Commission to help fund important nutrition and wellness support programs for low-income and at-risk families. Verdant Health Commission works to support programs that help the local community with health inequalities to improve quality of life for all.

Funds from the first grant, a \$75,000 award funded over three years, is set to expand the Foundation's annual summer camp program, ensuring any child from 5 – 18 can receive food and enriching activities over the summer months. The Foundation will continue to serve nutritious meals alongside fun, healthy, and educational activities, and plans to partner with the YMCA and the Boys and Girls Club to provide field trips and greater access to much needed resources.

The second grant, a \$22,000 COVID-19 rolling award, will be used to better serve low-income families who continue to be negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. The Foundation will expand Nourishing Network pop-up pantries to provide resources to more families, particularly with the cultural diversity of the district in mind. A greater, and more diverse, selection of food will be available at pop-up pantries to ensure every family is served with the healthy food they need.

"The pandemic is still hitting low-income families in our community very hard, and our Nourishing Network program is still seeing very high demand," says Deborah Brandi, Executive Director. "We're working hard to help reduce hunger in our community and provide the health and wellness resources our families need. We're very thankful to Verdant for helping make this possible."
