Verdant Health Foundation Awards Foundation for Edmonds School District \$140,000 to Support the Nourishing Network

The Foundation has received a generous grant of \$140,000 from the Verdant Health Commission. Dedicated to the health and wellness of the local community, the Verdant Health Commission provides local non-profits with funding to help vulnerable persons gain access to important health and nutrition services.

The award will be used to fund important programs through the Nourishing Network, which currently serves more than 500 low income and homeless children and families. Children struggling with food insecurity face a range of negative effects, including lower academic performance, struggles with anxiety and depression, and difficulty getting along with their peers.

The Nourishing Network helps children and families by providing weekend meal kits, summer meals, staples through Pop-Up Pantries, emergency food boxes, and holiday meals.

"Providing food bags, pantry staples, and weekend meals lessens the stress on the entire family and keeps them from wondering where their next meal will come from," says Deborah Brandi, Executive Director. "We're very thankful to Verdant for this generous award and the ways in which it will positively impact the children in our district."
