Foundation Expands Scholarship Alliance, Partners with Hubbard Family Foundation and Lynnwood Rotary Club.

The Foundation will partner with the Rotary Club of Lynnwood ("the Club"), the Lynnwood Rotary Community Foundation, and the Hubbard Family Foundation for academic scholarships. The partnership between the Foundation and the three organizations is an integral part of a larger alliance between the Foundation and multiple individuals and community organizations. The alliance provides thousands of dollars in scholarships each year to deserving Edmonds School District students.

These new partnerships create three new scholarship opportunities for seniors graduating from the Edmonds School District in 2023.

In 2010, the Martha Lake Community Club generously provided a gift to the Lynnwood Rotary Community Foundation. Multiple vocational, trade school, and academic scholarships will be awarded from this generous gift and will be named the Martha Lake Community / Lynnwood Rotary Scholarship.

The Club will also be awarding an academic scholarship honoring long-time Rotarian and community philanthropist Bernie Sigler. A tireless advocate for education, and for the residents of our community, this memorial scholarship will honor his legacy of service. Each scholarship will recognize outstanding students in the Edmonds School District who demonstrate a commitment to others through community service. Award amounts will vary each year.

"The Rotary Club of Lynnwood are a shining example of serving our community," says Deborah Brandi, Executive Director. "We are honored to award these scholarships to deserving students so they can continue their educational journey and help make our world a better place for everyone."

The third scholarship is in partnership with the Hubbard Family Foundation. Established by Larry Hubbard, a dedicated and longstanding member of the Edmonds community, in 1983 to "enhance the quality of life for the citizens of the City of Edmonds and South Snohomish County."

A generous and kind citizen, Larry Hubbard lived his life serving the people of Edmonds. As the fourth generation of a long line of Edmonds pioneers, Larry was invested in the city and took over the family insurance business after his father, Ernie, passed away in 1963. Larry also served as the Edmonds' city attorney and as a member of the first city planning commission.

Larry's legacy continues in Edmonds today. Larry purchased and willed the Edmonds Memorial Cemetery & Columbarium to the city, which continues as an active cemetery today. Alongside this, Larry created the Hubbard Family Foundation to provide grants and scholarships to those within the Edmonds School District's boundaries. Two

graduating seniors per high school will be awarded a Hubbard Family Foundation Scholarship to pursue post-secondary education.

"We are so honored to continue the legacy of Larry Hubbard and his family," says Deborah. "His contributions have had a huge impact on so many in our community. This is a wonderful opportunity to enrich the lives of our graduating high school seniors and help them become the champions of our future. We're thrilled to partner with these amazing community organizations to help our students."



On the Job Training Pilot Program

Do you own a business or work for one that is interested in supporting high schoolers to become job ready? Then the Foundation's new pilot On the Job Training program, in partnership with the ESD's Career Connected Learning Program, is for you!

This program works to provide workforce development and on-the-job training program for seniors this fall. Eligible students could also receive a scholarship upon successful program completion.

Students will be placed with employers for a paid internship to help students build basic job skills and demonstrate soft skills such as attendance and punctuality.
