Charitable Giving in 2022


Are you thinking about the best ways to make a charitable donation for the 2022 tax year?

Consider giving appreciated securities held for over a year, such as mutual funds, appreciated stock, and exchange traded funds as a charitable gift! These offer a great way to donate whilst still getting your full tax deduction.

Or, perhaps you'd like to make a qualified charitable distribution using a traditional IRA to donate directly to the Foundation? If you hold a traditional IRA and are age 70 ½ or older, you can donate to a qualified charity, such as the Foundation. A qualified charitable distribution may satisfy your required minimum distribution and up to \$100,000 of qualified charitable distributions may be excluded annually from your taxable income. The qualified charitable distribution needs to be made directly by the IRA custodian/trustee to the Foundation.

Please consult with your tax advisor prior to contributing under either of these scenarios to confirm your eligibility and charitable deduction

benefits.
