Foundation for Edmonds School District Receives \$140,000 Grant in Support of the Nourishing Network

The Foundation has received a \$140,000 grant from Verdant Health Commission to help fund the Nourishing Network, providing important health, nutrition, and wellness programs for low-income and at-risk families. Verdant Health Commission works to support programs that help the local community with health inequalities to improve quality of life for all.

The Nourishing Network provides important food security services for students in the Edmonds School District, including pop up pantries, weekend meal kits, summer meals, and holiday meals. The Nourishing Network serves 500 students and their families with meals and access to food boxes, ensuring no child or their family goes hungry. In the past year, over 600 more families began using the district's free meals program, highlighting a more significant need for food security.

These important services by the Nourishing Network ensure that children and families who are unable to access a food bank during the work day, or free and reduced lunches during the summer months, have access to fresh and shelf stable food items, helping to fill the gap when food banks are closed or work and school schedules don't allow for access to other local services.

The Foundation partners with the Lynnwood Food Bank, Edmonds Food Bank, and Mountlake Terrace Concern for Neighbors Food Bank to provide fresh items for seven pop-up pantries run by the Nourishing Network throughout the district.

"We are so thankful for the support of the Verdant Health Commission," says Deborah Brandi, Executive Director. "With their help and the important partnerships we have with our local food banks and other community partners, we're able to meet important needs in our community."

On the Job Training Pilot Program

Do you own a business or work for one that is interested in supporting high schoolers to become job ready? Then the Foundation's new pilot On the Job Training program, in partnership with the ESD's Career Connected Learning Program, is for you!

This program works to provide workforce development and on-the-job training program for seniors this fall. Eligible students could also receive a scholarship upon successful program completion.

Students will be placed with employers for a paid internship to help students build basic job skills and demonstrate soft skills such as attendance and punctuality.
